Money Matters: Four Month Budget Update

We have completed the first four months (1/3) of our 2013 budget cycle and some trends are starting to emerge. Both our income and expenses remain below our budget estimates, with expenses exceeding income by about \$2,800 per month. In other words, we are spending more than we take in.

Trinity had accumulated an adequate reserve in 2012 and Session anticipated drawing down that reserve in 2013 when it adopted this year's budget. We have sufficient financial reserves to see us through the remainder of this year. Session will review our budget midyear and make necessary adjustments.

This is a very exciting time at Trinity. We face many challenges, but we also have many opportunities. We look forward to all the wondrous things God will bring us throughout the remainder of the year. The next page displays a budget summary for the period of January 1st to April 30th.

COMING SOON: M & M's Presents A Scam-Alert Workshop for Seniors

The Yolo County District Attorney Elder Protection Unit will be hosting a workshop at Trinity Presbyterian Church during the M & Ms meeting June 15, 2013. The workshop will identify how older adults can protect themselves against crimes such as identity theft, telemarketing fraud, door-to-door and phony check/lottery scams. According to the FBI, Identity Theft is now one of the fastest-growing crimes in the Country, and citizens may not even know they are a victim until creditors start calling.

Since fraud schemes are ever evolving, continuing education is essential to reduce the number of potential victims. Fortunately, awareness is a very effective tool in combating these types of crimes. The District Attorney's office believes that teaching older adults how to recognize and avoid these scams is an effective tool to combat crime. You will learn simple and practical ways to help reduce your exposure to things like check fraud, skimming and home invasion robbery.

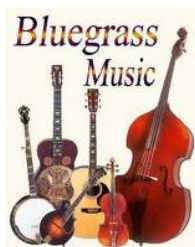

Projecting Great Worship

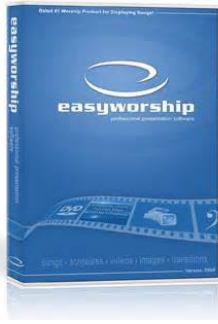
