On top of the fiscal generosity, students at Stonegate Elementary brought in a couple of hundred bags of canned food, as kids and their parents reached into their pantries to fill ours, and ultimately the food needs of the people of West Sacramento would be met with bags of groceries.

Individuals stepped up and offered steady commitments of shopping. In addition, we picked up a webmaster, and a couple of volunteer coordinators. We now have new ideas, new people, and new food sources.

Unbelievable, but not unprecedented, we experience incredible Providence every month at Out of the Box Ministries. If you volunteer, you are there to see and experience. So what is the lesson/takeaway in all of this?

Unlike Aesop, who ended his fables with the moral written in black and white, I am going to end with a question.

In John 21:15-17, Jesus offers an incredible opportunity for us to demonstrate our love for Him. He asks Peter 3 times if Peter loves him. Three times Peter answers yes, and 3 times Jesus follows up with instruction to:

- 1) Feed my lambs.
- 2) Take care of my sheep.
- 3) Feed my sheep.

If you have a special skill you would like to share with others, please call Jane Gentry at 916.372.3485 and let her know you are willing to conduct a craft workshop.


